



Sprout Search Operators Cheatsheet |

IF YOU WANT TO	USE THIS	TO FIND
Search for Tweets from handles with a specified location	<u>bio_location:chicago “cubs”</u>	All users with the location Chicago in their bio when the Tweet mentions “Cubs”
Search for Tweets from bios containing a specific keyword	<u>bio_contains: “customer support”</u>	All bios containing the keywords “customer support”
Search for Tweets from handles bio-located in a specific country	<u>profile_country_code:us “lakes”</u>	All users with their set geotag country as US, containing the keyword “lakes” in their bio
Filter Tweets by follower count (influencers)	<u>(followers_count:1000 (“please DM”)</u>	All users who have 1,000 or more followers with the phrase “please DM” in the Tweet
Filter Tweets from verified profiles (influencers)	<u>is:verified “Thanks for the RT”</u>	All verified Twitter users with Tweets containing “Thanks for the RT”
Find Tweets with keyword and a link	<u>“Groupon” has:links</u>	All Tweets with links containing the word “Groupon”
Find Tweets with keyword and media	<u>“The Daily Show” has:media</u>	All Tweets containing media with the keywords “The Daily Show”
Find Tweets with specific keyword in a URL	<u>url_contains: insights</u>	All Tweets with a URL that contains the keyword “Insights”
Find Tweets with negative or positive sentiment	<u>“Sprout Social :)”</u>	All Tweets containing keywords “Sprout Social” and the sentiment “:)”
