



## Twitter Search Operators Cheatsheet |

IF YOU WANT TO	USE THIS	TO FIND
Search for single or multi-word phrases	<u>"Panera" "Bread Company"</u> 🔍	All Tweets containing the keywords "Panera" or "Bread Company"
Search for keywords with multiple other keywords	<u>("Adele" OR "Sam Smith") ("James Bond" OR "Bond movie")</u> 🔍	All Tweets containing "Adele" or "Sam Smith" with the keywords "James Bond" or "Bond movie"
Search for #hashtags	<u>#museumweek</u> 🔍	All Tweets containing #museumweek
Search for Tweets excluding words, phrases, handles, hashtags or locations	<u>"beer" -root</u> 🔍	All Tweets containing the keyword "beer" and excluding "root"
Search for Tweets excluding words, phrases, handles, hashtags or locations within multiple groups	<u>(Apple OR Mac) -(iPhone OR computer OR iTunes)</u> 🔍	All Tweets containing "Apple" or "Mac" but excluding keywords "iPhone" or "computer" or "iTunes"
Find Tweets sent <b>to</b> a specific twitter handle	<u>to:sproutsocial</u> 🔍	All Tweets sent to the user @SproutSocial
Find Tweets sent <b>from</b> a specific twitter handle	<u>from:sproutsocial</u> 🔍	All Tweets sent from the user @SproutSocial
Find Tweets containing the specified twitter handle	<u>@sproutsocial</u> 🔍	All Tweets mentioning the user @SproutSocial
Filter Tweets by language	<u>"Rio 2016" lang:pt</u> 🔍	All Tweets with the keywords "Rio 2016" and filtered to languages only in Portuguese
